### Next week in Cherry Class

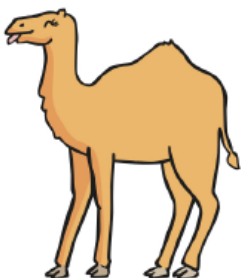
We will be learning about wild and endangered animals and their habitats.
