

a building or place that is important in history

the ancient civilisation connected with Rome

a large area of land including lots of countries ruled over by an emperor

the **ruler** of an empire

the continuation of the Roman Empire, centred around the city of Constantinople (also known as the **Eastern Roman Empire**)

the capital city of the Byzantine Empire: previously called Byzantium and now present-day Istanbul (named after Emperor Constantine the Great)

a picture or a pattern made by putting small pieces of stone, glass or other materials together

a rounded roof of a building with a circle-shaped base

elaborately decorated

a painting of **Jesus, or another holy figure**, usually painted on wood and used by Christians for prayer and reflection
