### Next week in Cherry Class

We will start to focus on our mark making skills. We will use our gross motor skills to make large clockwise and anti-clockwise circles with ribbons while we listen to different types of music. We will also make marks with chalks, pencils and crayons on large pieces of paper.

We will also work as a team to create a collage. We will support the children to use scissors to carefully make snips in paper and we will stick the pieces into a circular design. As we work with the children we will support them to learn new vocabulary and speak in short sentences.
