We have had a super busy week learning about Diwali. We enjoyed using clay to make small diya lamps. They will take a little while to dry and once they have, we will send them home.

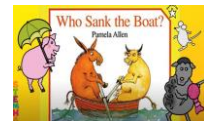
We also used glue and colourful rice to decorate Rangoli patterns.

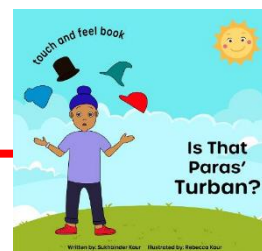
