Christmas Raffle

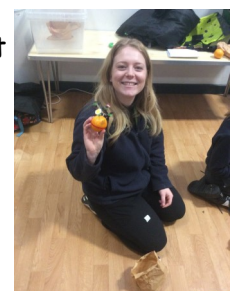
