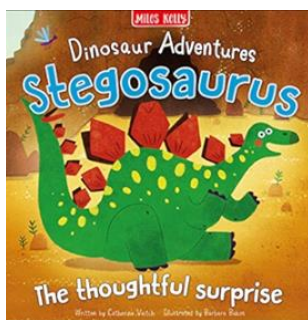




Highlights from this week
