### Next week in Cherry Class

We will be learning all about farm animals and their babies. We will be enjoying the story "What the ladybird heard".

We will be matching numbers to quantities and making repeating patterns.

We will also continue to take part in fun activities from our phonics programme.

#### Phonics - Phase one

Did you know there are seven areas in phase one phonics which are essential for children to develop their reading skills? They are:

- Environmental sounds.
- Instrumental sounds.
  - Body percussion (e.g. clapping and stamping)
- Rhythm and rhyme.
  - Alliteration.
  - Voice sounds.
- Oral blending and segmenting (e.g. hearing that d-o-g makes 'dog')

Here at preschool we cover all these aspects on a weekly basis.

#### Forest school sessions - Update

We have exciting news! We have had some volunteers who will be helping us with our forest school sessions. I am planning to run on-site sessions every Wednesday morning from 9.30am to 11.00am.

I will run the first session on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> April. Children who attend on this day, will need wellington boots, waterproof coats and waterproof trousers. We will be outside whatever the weather! Please remember to pack these items to avoid disappointment.
