

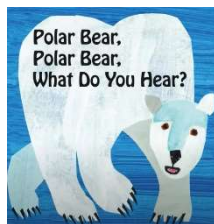


Highlights from this week

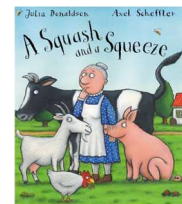
Next week in Cherry Class
