



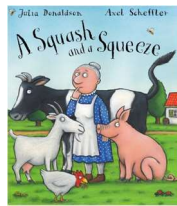
Highlights from this week

We also enjoyed this story!



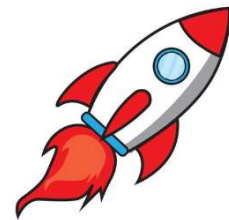
We have focused on hearing the initial sound "c", that can be found in words like: caterpillar, cat, and coin.
