We will also focus lots of our learning on "The Train Ride" story.

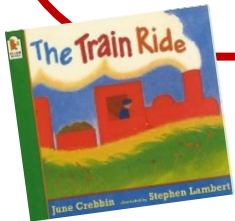
We will listen carefully to different vehicle noises as well as talk about how important it is to hold hands with our grown-ups when crossing roads.
