Writing

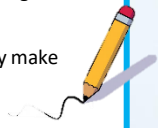
- Developing greater accuracy in using full stops and capital letters.

Multiplication and Division

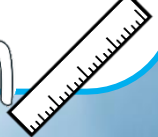
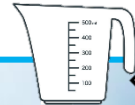
- Learning to count in, and recognise steps of 2, 5 10

Plants

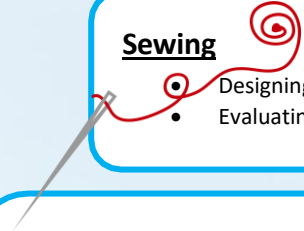
- Plants around us
